#### WEC's extension works continue

**Alhamdulillah** with the support & duas of the community, WEC extension works started in January 2019. Copies of the extension plans & construction contract are available at WEC Office.

We appreciate your continuing support to fulfil the community's growing religious, educational & social needs. You can contribute to this sadaqah jariya (continuous charity) by **sponsoring a musalla** (prayer space) for £250 each. **Fundraising target** is £75,000.

The extended centre will provide a wider range of facilities to accommodate the growing religious, educational and social needs of our local community, including a much-needed nursery in the area. This will also allow the Centre to expand its prayer space; iSyllabus school classes; Mini Marvels (Mother & Toddler Group); dawah & sports activities in sha Allah.

The Trust has designed a beautiful & iconic new extension building (plans are available at WEC Reception), which will aim to serve as East Renfrewshire's first Islamic Eco-Community Centre, to accommodate around 1,000 users, with its low carbon footprint & eco-friendly design in sha Allah.



#### **COVID-19** Update

We hope that all of our community members are keeping safe within their homes during this difficult time. The Climate Hero Awards recognised the achievements of volunteers at Climate Challenge Fund Gathering 2019. We are delighted that two of Our Green Guardians team volunteers were among the selected 20 Climate Heroes from across Scotland. Sajda Raza won the CCF Food Heroes award and Rashida Omar won the CCF Community Impact Heroes award.

#### Another successful CCF funded project

As our 'Bringing East-Renfrewshire Back to Basics' project came to a close in March, we are pleased to share with you the successes of our project. We could not have achieved these amazing outcomes without the help of each of our volunteers & every community member who joined in with our workshops & activities.

- **259** lifetime tonnes of CO<sub>2</sub>e saved through all strands of the project
- **865** people engaged in climate change awareness activities
- 223 people actively involved in the project
- **107** workshops delivered through the project
- 32 climate conversations run with the community
- **9** events held during the project
- **30** training courses delivered during the project
- 278 volunteer hours given to the project
- **30** volunteers on the project
- 6 local high schools involved in the project
- **35.3cm**<sup>2</sup> of growing space revived at the Centre
- 73 households started growing or composting at home
- 75kgs of home grown food produced by growers
- 1,140kgs of unsold food from Gregg's distributed to the community
- 32.1 tonnes of textiles and other waste diverted from landfill
- 18616
- 54 tonnes of food waste diverted from landfill
- 13.4 tonnes of car emission saved from sustainable travel
- 217.5 miles increased through walking and cycling
