

WEC extension works started!

Alhamdulillah! With the support & duaas of the community, WEC extension works started in January 2019. Copies of the extension plans & construction contract are available at WEC Office.

We appreciate your continuing support to fulfil the community's growing religious, educational & social needs. You can contribute to this sadaqah jariya (continuous charity) by sponsoring a musalla (prayer space) for £250 each. Fundraising target is \pounds 600,000.

The extended centre will provide a wider range of facilities to accommodate the growing religious, educational and social needs of our local community, including a much-needed Nursery in the area. This will also allow the Centre to expand its prayer space; iSyllabus school classes; Mini Marvels (Mother & Toddler Group); dawah & sports activities in sha Allah.

The Trust has designed a beautiful & iconic new extension building (plans are available at WEC Reception), which will aim to serve as East Renfrewshire's first Islamic Eco-Community Centre, to accommodate around 1,000 users, with its low carbon footprint & eco-friendly design in sha Allah.

The project delivered a variety of events to help the community increase understanding of climate

We would like to announce a new member of the Green Guardians team, our Community Fridge! We have been taking donations of unsold food from Greggs in Thornliebank at the end of each night, which would normally be put in the bin. We would love it if you could volunteer to help us collect & sort these food items to help keep this food out of landfill.

In our first week we have taken and distributed 437 separate items of food, weighing just under 39kg. That's around half the body weight of an adult and enough to fill around half of your wheelie bin at home.

We have been running a cycle club for our community members to learn how to ride a bike & go on cycle rides. Our ladies had been really awesome! They have proved that neither age, weather nor pain can stop them from coming out & enjoying the sessions.

WEC awarded £2,500 from Thornliebank Together public fund by ER Council



The public living, working, volunteering or attending a school in Thornliebank voted for their favourite projects to be awarded £2,500 out of £25,000 from public money. Woodfarm Education Centre was one of ten winners out of a total of 20 projects.

This money will go towards supporting the CCF funded project in installing a new bike shelter, cycles and secure cycle storage unit for the community centre users in part of building a cycling culture within East Renfrewshire. A range of cycles are already available for free hire to use by any of the centre's users.
